Scholarship Program Information

The HTIAA-Houston Annual Scholarship Fund was created for Incoming Freshmen Students and Transfer Students enrolled at Huston-Tillotson University. The scholarship award amount will be determined based upon the Houston Chapter fundraiser.

Scholarship Requirements

In order to qualify for this scholarship, students must:

- Be an Incoming Freshman or Transfer Student at H-T in the Fall of 2010;
- GPA of 2.5 or higher (must present an official transcript);
- Must have passed all state mandatory test, including but not limited to the TAKS, and be fully eligible to attend the University in the Fall of 2010.
- Show financial need; must provide a copy of your award letter;
- Two letters of recommendation: one from a school official and one from a community member (neither can be from a family member)
- A letter detailing your involvement on a community service project- must be on official letterhead.
- **A one-page (two page maximum not including cover page)**, typewritten essay (no more than 12 font), **must include a cover page or the essay will not be considered**; students may choose from **one** of the following topics:
 - Why I want to attend Huston-Tillotson University?
 - What are my goals while attending Huston-Tillotson University and after graduating from Huston-Tillotson University?

These requirements were established by the scholarship donor; they may not be altered.

Application Instructions

In order to apply for this scholarship, students must complete the attached application. Students must also submit a copy of their official transcript, essay, along required letters indicated on the previous page. Students must also submit a current photo and a short biography.

The application deadline is July 2, 2010. All Applications must be postmarked by this time to be considered. No late or incomplete applications will be processed.

Disbursement Process

Once scholarship winners have been selected, award letters will be sent to the student. Students must send proof of college enrollment to
